#### **Catalog Course Description**

Continuation of materials and skills developed in MUSE 101. Continued practice and skill development in melodic and rhythmic dictation, intervals, and sightsinging. Required of all music majors. 36 lecture hours.

### **Course Objectives**

- · aurally recognize major, minor, diminished and augmented triads
- · notate dictated melodies and rhythms in compound meters
- · sight sing melodies combining rhythmic and melodic elements
