Catalog Course Description

This course provides instruction and physical participation in the basic techniques necessary for good singing including posture, breathing, range extension and musicality. Additionally, beginning harmonic ear training provides tools for gradual improvement and musical achievement. Performance is required. 36 lecture hours, 18 lab hours arranged.

Course Objectives

- have a basic recognition of personal and professional attributes necessary for successful singing such as proper breathing, posture, performance attitude, basic sound emission, and pitch recognition.
- demonstrate understanding of a basic musical vocabulary of proper vocal production and identify beginning terms and symbols used in sheet music
