- Computer Operations managing software-based (Pro Tools, etc.)
  audio recording and editing systems
- 2. The Digital Audio Workstation session set-up, signal routing and recording; file organization
- Studio Systems the console, monitors, patch bay and recording hardware
- Microphone Techniques selecting and placing microphones for individual and small ensemble recording
- Studio Sessions pre-production and session planning, completion of individual and group recording projects

#### **Lab Content**

- Computer workstation operating system, file management, standard conventions
- 2. Basic software-based audio recording and editing
- 3. Recording studio set-up, hardware connections and operation

- 4. Instrument and vocal mic'ing with single and multi-mic techniques
- 5. Individual and group recording and mixing projects
